Opening doors through the TUNE project: Developing intercultural understanding through blended exchange in traditional/folk music higher education



[TUNE \(Traditional Music Undergraduate Network in Europe\)](#) is a 3-year Erasmus+ Cooperation

Partnership project (2021–2024) that aims to promote strategic cooperation between five European higher music education institutions through the development of an innovative joint module in traditional music based on blended mobility.

During this online session, leaders of the project's work packages will present some of the different ways that students have worked together online and in person during the first three semesters of the project. In particular, the presentation will

focus on how international cooperation and exchange in the field of traditional/folk music higher education can foster the development of intercultural understanding. The progress of the joint module will also be presented and discussed.

This session may also serve as an introduction to a pre-conference workshop and parallel session about the TUNE project, both to be held at the AEC Congress and General Assembly on 9 and 10 November 2023 in The Hague.
