

# Higher education in folk music in Norway

- USN Rauland (previously Telemark University College)
  - One-year programme from 1987
  - BA and MA in folk music from 2005
- Norwegian Academy of Music
  - BA in performance from 1995
- Ole Bull Academy (University of Bergen)
  - Two-year programme from 1996
  - From 2004: four-year BA
