Traditional music in Estonia until 1990

*Live tradition until 1930s

*Big recording sessions at the beginning of the 20th century (biggest 1936-38), vast collection of recorded tradition

*Soviet times - **folk** music as part of Soviet ideology, rather seen as amateur entertainment, not professional music









*Traditional music is taught in Viljandi and Tallinn

*In Viljandi - steady amount of eager students

*Strong cooperation between Estonian traditional music centre and Viljandi Culture Academy

*Emphasis on teaching Estonian traditional music

*Encouraging students to use tradition and knowledge in modern way

*Research, development and creativity
